



Family Book Standard Guide

- Does not portray bad behavior or weak character traits as humorous, entertaining, or desirable:

laziness, negativity, flippant attitude, disrespect, cruelty, violence, gossip, pride, vanity, self-centeredness, revenge, greed, worldliness, unkindness, immodesty, immorality, lack of depth of character

- Does not make dysfunctional family relationships seem normal and acceptable
- Promotes respect and appreciation for parents, siblings, teachers, and peers
- Portrays moral values as desirable and worth the effort
- Portrays learning and education as desirable and noble
- Is free from swear words, potty language, crude language, and taking the Lord's name and God's name in vain
- Is free from violence, cruelty, or bad behavior that is too graphic in description, overly dark, solely for entertainment, or made to look acceptable
