

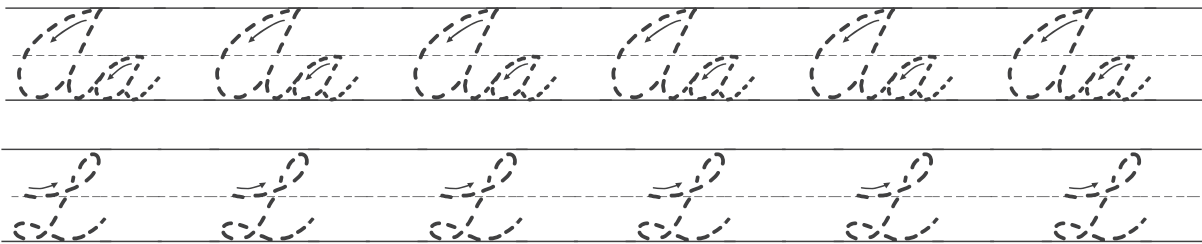

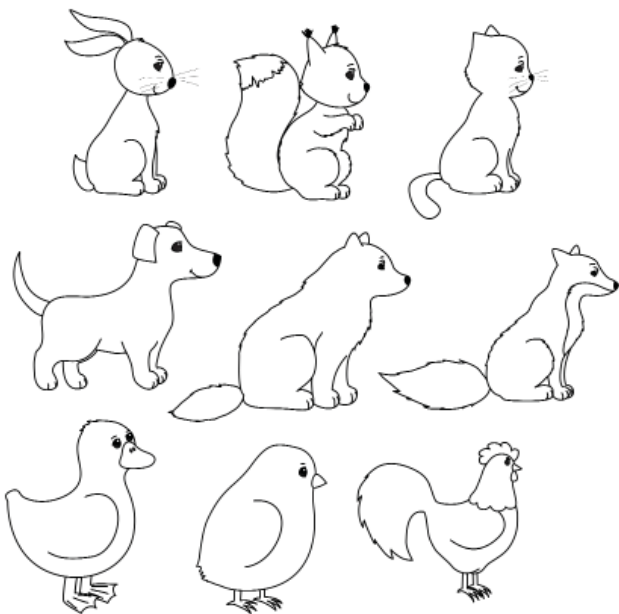
A noun is a word for a person, place, or thing.

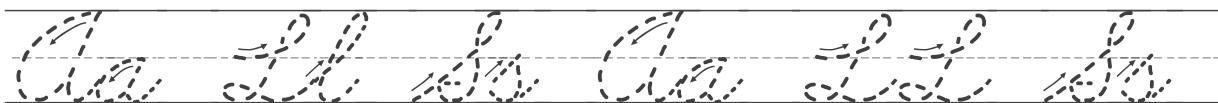

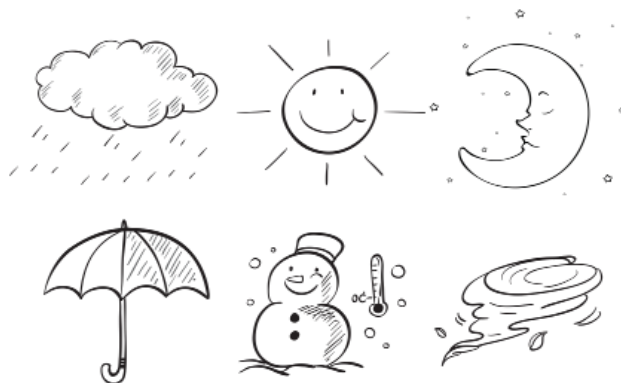

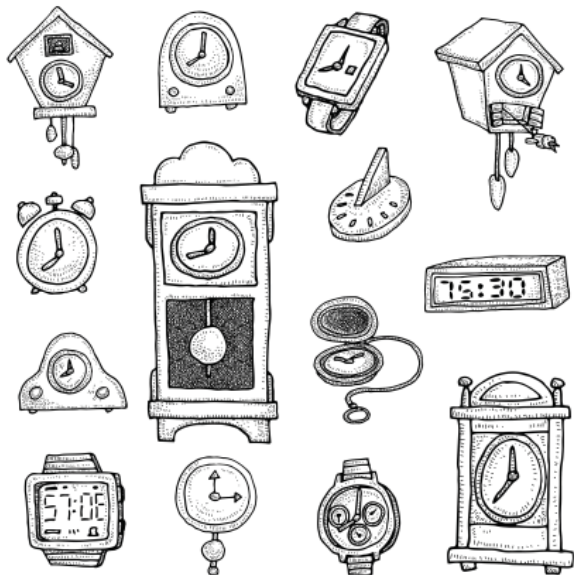
