Master Supply List

These quantities are per child.

Paint

- **Watercolor paint**—for 7 projects (set of 16 colors)
- **Acrylic paint**—for 3 projects, including white, black, brown, teals, blues, and greens
- **Craft paint**—black and white
- **Tempera paint**—black and white
- **Tempera paint**—a few colors for making sidewalk chalk (or food coloring)
- **Nail polish**—at least 3–4 colors
- **Washable Paint**—yellow, dark green, and light green

Paper

- Card stock (8.5"x11")—11 sheets of white and 1 sheet each of yellow and blue
- Watercolor paper—5 sheets of white
- Parchment paper for 3 projects
- Colored construction paper
- Newspaper or scrap paper
- Craft foam sheet
- Two brown paper lunch bags

Felt

- 1 - 8.5"x11" piece of orange
- 1 - 3"x8" piece of light green

Yarn, Twine, String

- Misc. yarn including—green (two 30" lengths), orange, yellow, and white
- Twine or string, 9" per ornament made (see pg 26)
- Ribbons and/or twine
- 18"–20" of string or cord
- 1 yarn needle

Writing Utensils

- Colored pencils, including brown or black
- Brown and black markers
- Colorful fine-tipped markers
- Green and brown oil or chalk pastels, or crayons
- Pencil, pen, and eraser

Tape

- Duct tape
- Double-sided tape
- A small piece of colored or decorative tape

Craft Items

- Pipe cleaners—at least 12" long, including green, brown, and tan (4)
- A variety of craft items for decorating trees (see page 16)
- A large handful of red, orange, yellow, white, and brown pony beads
- Sequins, rhinestones, or pom poms
- 3–4 straight corks
- A 2" piece of straw for each bird feeder ornament and 1 straw for the leaf pendant project
- Cotton swabs
- Skewers (at least 4"–6") or toothpicks
- Jumbo craft sticks

- Watercolor paint (set of 16 colors)
- A piece of white watercolor paper
- A pointed paintbrush
- A cup of water
- Paper towels
- A black marker

Yarn Pumpkins

- Orange, yellow, or white yarn
- Balloons (any size)
- Green and brown pipe cleaners
- Scissors
- Small bowls
- White glue (use Elmer's Glue-All™ for stiffer pumpkins)

Bird Feeder Ornaments

- 1 ¼ tsp unflavored gelatin (1 pack)
- 1 ½ Tbsp corn syrup
- 2 cup bird seed
- ⅓ cup flour
- ¼ cup water
- Cooking spray, butter, or shortening
- Metal cookie cutters
- Parchment paper
- Twine or string, 9" for each ornament
- A 2" piece of straw for each bird feeder ornament
- A saucepan and a medium sized bowl
- A spatula

Nature Crowns

- Duct tape
- A measuring tape
- Ribbons and/or twine
- An assortment of sticks, twigs, flower stems, and other items that you've collected from outside
- Glue (Fabri-Tac™) or double-sided tape

Kaleidoscope Rocks

- White craft paint
- A paintbrush
- Smooth rocks
- Scrap paper
- A variety of nail polish colors
- Skewers or toothpicks
- A deep glass bowl with cold water
- Latex gloves
- Nail polish remover

Colorful Grid Landscape

- A pencil and an eraser
- A piece of white watercolor paper
- Watercolor paint (set of 16 colors)
- Black craft paint
- 1 medium flat paint brush
- 1 small pointed round paint brush
- A cup of water
- Paper towels
- A paper plate or palette

Simple Chick Watercolor

- Watercolor paint (set of 16 colors)
- A pencil
- A piece of white watercolor paper
- A pointed paintbrush
- A small round paintbrush
- A cup of water
- Paper towels

Galaxy Watercolor

- Watercolor paint (set of 16 colors)
- A piece of white watercolor paper
- A pointed paintbrush
- A large flat paintbrush
- White acrylic paint
- A cup of water
- Paper towels

Beaded Corn on the Cob

- 4 tan pipe cleaners (12" long)
- A large handful of red, orange, yellow, white, and brown pony beads

Craft Stick Bracelet

- Jumbo craft sticks
- Hair elastics or rubber bands
- Jar lids with optional jars
- A decorating method (see page 45)

Lined Landscaping

- Colorful fine-tipped markers
- A piece of white card stock or paper

Moon Forest

- Small amounts of black and white tempera paint
- A medium paintbrush
- One cotton swab
- Scissors
- One sheet each of yellow, white, and blue card stock or construction paper
- Glue
- A pencil
- A small bowl

Homemade Sidewalk Chalk

- 1 cup Plaster of Paris
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup water
- A few colors of paint (tempera, poster paint, or food coloring)
- Bowls or cups and spoons for mixing (disposable is best)
- 2 pieces of card stock or chipboard for each piece of chalk
- Scissors
- Duct tape or packing tape
- Wax paper or parchment paper

Thumbprint Art

- Paper (any type)
- Yellow, dark green, and light green paint (washable is preferable)
- A paper plate

Heart Paper Plate

- A piece of paper
- A paper plate
- Yarn
- A yarn needle
- Scissors
- A hole punch, any size
- A pencil or pen
- Tape

Peacock Prints

- Acrylic paints in teals, blues, or greens, as well as white and black or brown
- A paper plate
- White card stock
- A large paintbrush (use one and wash out for each new color, or use four different brushes)
- A narrow/thin paintbrush

Leaf Print Pendant

- A straw
- A circle cookie cutter
- 18"–20" of string or cord
- 1" ball of air-dry clay
- Leaves or small items from nature
- A rolling pin (optional)
- 4–5 pony beads (optional)
- Wax or parchment paper (optional)

Dot Art Greeting Cards

- Paint
- Cotton swabs
- Card stock or construction paper
- An pencil with eraser
- Scissors

Japanese Cherry Tree

- Two brown paper lunch bags
- Pink tissue paper, cut into small squares
- Glue
- An old pencil
- Scissors
- A small bowl

Dandelion Art

- Construction paper (any color except white)
- Cotton swabs
- White paint
- Oil or chalk pastels (or crayons) in green and brown

Paper Flowers

- A variety of colored construction paper
- Green construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- A pen

Hot Air Balloons

- Watercolor brush
- Blue and brown watercolors
- White card stock or watercolor paper
- A black or brown marker
- A variety of colored construction paper
- A glue stick
- A pencil
- Scissors

Cork Sailboats

- 3–4 straight corks
- 2 wide rubber bands
- A 4"–6" inch skewer
- A hole punch
- Craft foam sheet
- A small piece of colored or decorative tape
- A nail or screw
- Scissors
