We are here to help in your homeschool journey! Use this shopping checklist to help you easily select courses for your family.

Language Arts

Our full-year language arts courses for preschool through high school thoroughly cover everything needed for teaching these language arts subjects: phonics, reading, literature, writing, spelling, vocabulary, grammar, usage, punctuation, geography, and art history and appreciation.

These courses are slightly advanced compared to public school grade levels. In general, children can begin on grade level unless extra reading help is needed. If you are unsure of which level to select, give your child our Language Arts Placement Test found at goodandbeautiful.com/placement.

Simply Good and Beautiful Math courses closely match public school grade levels. *Math K-3* course sets each come with a course book and math box. *Math 4 and 5* come with a course book, *Mental Math Map Mysteries*, physical answer key, and digital access to the video lessons. *Math 6* includes a two-part course book, answer key, and digital access to video lessons.

In most cases, the child's course level matches his or her grade level. Our math uses a spiral teaching method so that previously learned concepts are frequently reviewed. Give our Math Placement Test found at goodandbeautiful.com/placement if you are unsure of where to begin with your child.

Handwriting

Courses range from preschool to Level 7. Cursive instruction begins in Level 3. When in doubt, start on a lower level.



Science

Science for Little Hearts and Hands introduces children in preschool through second grade to the wonders of science.

Our family-style science units average 10-14 lessons each. We recommend families complete 3-5 science units per year. Units can be completed in any order.

New and updated science units are taught family style in a grades 3-8 format. Younger children can still participate in learning along with the family. All updates/new releases will be available by Summer 2023.

☐ History

Our history courses are designed for second grade through high school. We recommend beginning with *History Year 1*. Optional Read-Aloud Book Packs are available for each year of history.

Our *US Constitution and Government* course for grades 4–8 can be completed independently from any of our other history courses.

□ Extras & Electives

The Good and the Beautiful offers fun, optional extras and electives! Add them in when they work for your family. Choose a few for your child.

Library

Choose a collection of books at or around your child's reading level from The Good and the Beautiful Library and *The Good and the Beautiful Book List* for daily independent reading or family read-aloud time.

AGE/LEVEL GUIDE

"What do I need to order for my child?" This is one of the most common questions parents have. We advise parents to administer our Language Arts and Math Placement Tests found at goodandbeautiful.com/placement before purchasing items, as these tests will give you a more detailed look at your child's needs.
