## COMPOUND WORDS

When two words are combined to create a new word, it is called a compound word. The *Luke and Lily of the Lighthouse: Compound Words* memory game teaches compound words in a fun, engaging way with lighthouses beautifully illustrated by Ecaterina Leascenco, who also illustrated the *Luke and Lily of the Lighthouse* books. The game also expands memory and brain function for developing minds. For added fun, find as many compound words as you can in the *Luke and Lily of the Lighthouse* books!



## HOW TO PLAY

2–4 PLAYERS

Divide the cards into two sets: the blue set and the red set. Choose one set to play with. Lay the cards face down in a grid of four cards by four cards. The youngest player will go first, choosing two cards to flip over. If the lighthouses on the two cards match, the player makes a compound word from the two words, says it aloud, and keeps the cards. The player then gets another turn. If the lighthouses do not match, the player flips the two cards back over, face down, and the next youngest player takes a turn. Continue until all of the matches have been collected. The player with the most cards wins.
