“Oh, it will be a nest!”


Mom said.

As they passed the web,

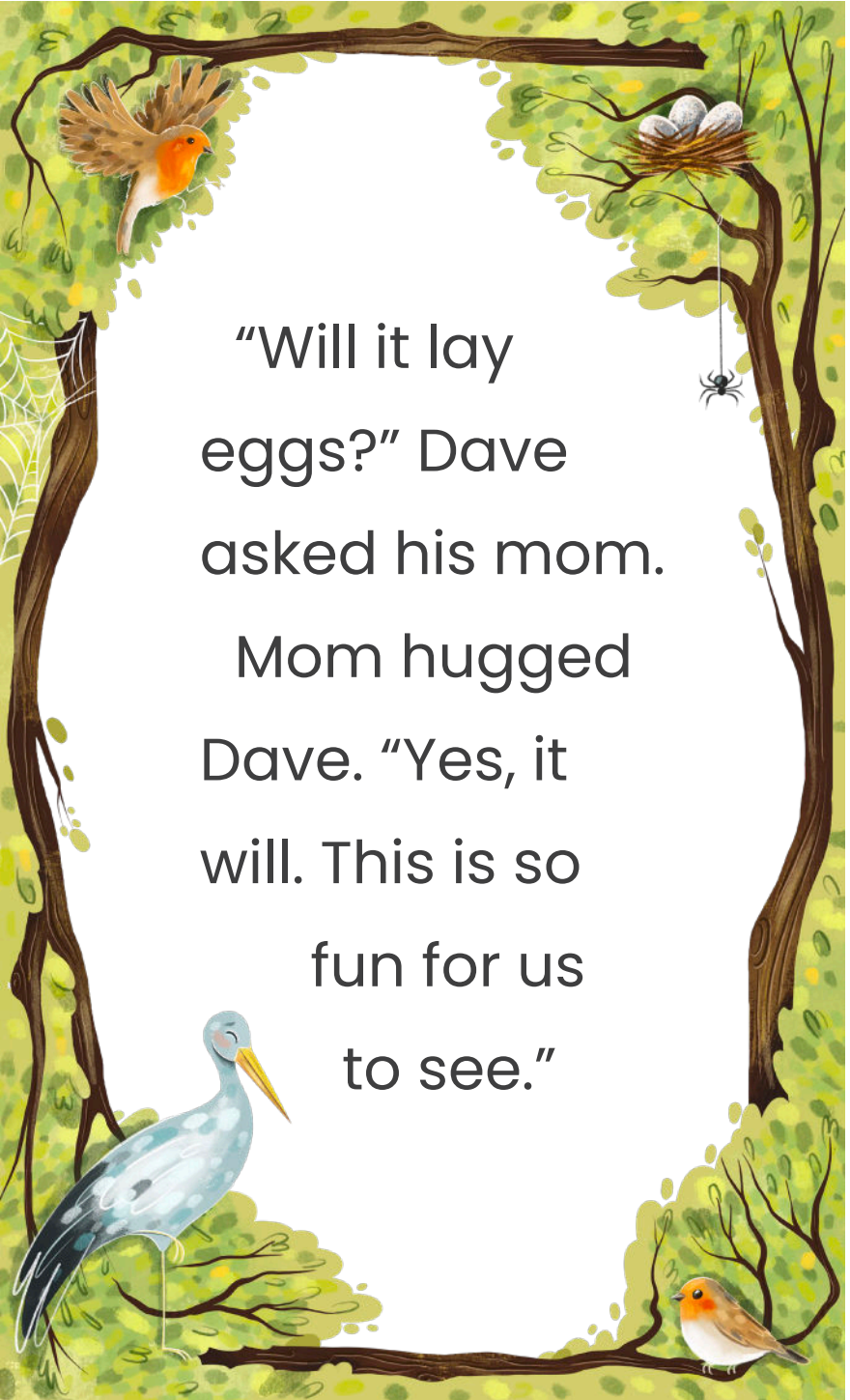


Dave looked at the spider.
