birds.

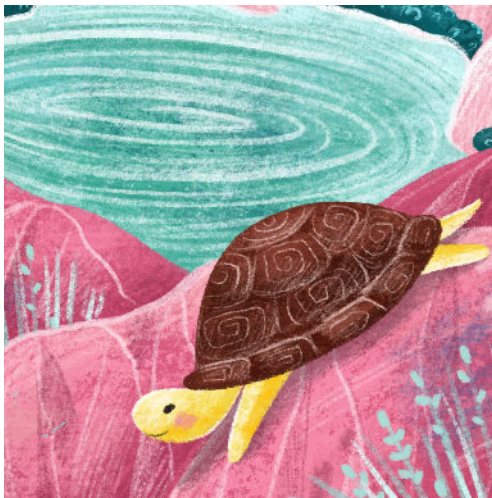


But many parts of the land
