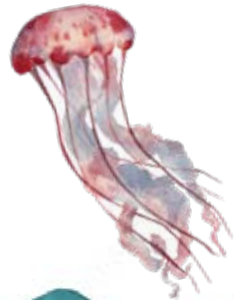

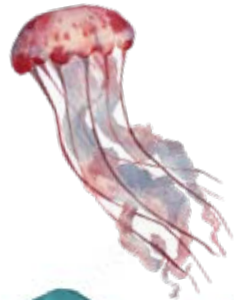

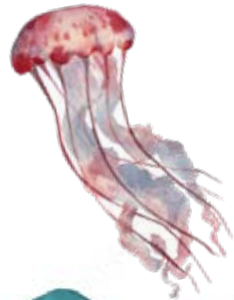

Object of the Game

Collect the most sets of 4 of a kind.

Starting the Game

Winning the Game
