

# Solar Eclipse Chalk Art



## Materials Needed:

Black paper (cardstock or construction)

White chalk or chalk pastel

White paper

Scissors

Round bowl 4"-6" in diameter

Tape

Pencil



## Instructions:

1. Place the bowl upside down on the white paper and trace the rim onto the white paper with your pencil.

2. Cut out the circle and roll a piece of tape onto the back to temporarily secure it to the center of the black paper.



3. With the chalk, trace the edge of the white circle 2-4 times until you see a bold white circle on your black paper.



4. Hold the white circle in place to make sure it doesn't move. With your other hand, pull a fingertip from the edge of the white circle outward, away from the circle. Repeat this until you have gone all the way around the circle.



5. Carefully remove the white circle and tape to reveal your solar eclipse.

6. Optional: A parent can use an art fixative or hairspray outside to lightly spray the paper so the chalk does not smear.
