
Hello Thank you for joining The Good and the Beautiful Summer Reading Program. Did you know that every book you read affects you?

The Bible teaches us to seek things that are **TRUE**, **HONEST**, **PURE**, **VIRTUOUS**, and **LOVELY** (Philippians 4:8). This applies to all things, even books. I encourage you to always have those words be your guide when choosing what books you will and will not read. Ask yourself, "Is this book pure? Is it virtuous? Is it lovely?"
